



The Court hereby adopts the following administrative order:

No visitor to the Choctaw Nation Judicial Courthouses is permitted to bring any electronic device into the Courthouses, except as set forth in this Order. "Electronic devices" shall include cellular devices, personal digital assistants, computers, laptops, iPads or similar devices. Electronic devices and recordings are only allowed inside the Courthouses as follows:

1. Attorneys admitted to the Choctaw Nation Bar Association, employees of the Choctaw Nation and any member of law enforcement may bring electronic devices into the Courthouses, as long as the electronic devices are silenced while inside the Courthouses. Only individuals identified in this Paragraph may bring their silenced electronic devices into the Courtrooms.
2. Attorneys may obtain prior Court approval for a witness or other person not identified above to have an electronic device inside the Courthouses by emailing a written request at least one day prior to a scheduled proceeding to: Bailiffs@choctawnation.com. Any same day requests for approval to bring in electronic devices should be addressed directly with the Judge presiding over the hearing in which the witness/person is to appear. In no event shall any witness/person identified in this Paragraph bring an electronic device into a Courtroom without Court approval.
3. All other visitors to the Courthouses not identified herein are required to have prior Court approval to bring any electronic device into the Courthouses and Courtrooms.
4. During any jury orientation or jury term, no potential juror may bring any electronic device inside the Courthouses.
5. In no event shall any person be allowed to record any Court proceedings without prior approval from the Presiding District Court Judge.
